FIFTEEN COMPANIES RECEIVE NEW YORK STATE SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION

The Office of General Services Commissioner today announced that the following fifteen businesses have recently been certified by the Office of General Services' (OGS) Division of Service-Disabled Veterans' Business Development (DSDVBD):

The Division was created by Governor Andrew Cuomo in May, 2014 with enactment of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act. As of February 22, 2018, a total of 442 businesses have been certified.
